








Feature Spotlight










A Day in the Life: My Creative Process

Midday

Physical Activity Practicing soccer drills to improve agility, endurance, and coordination.

Strenght Training Engaging in strength training and cardio workouts to maintain fitness.

Afternoon

Execution Translating sketches into digital compositions using Figma, and Illustrator. Refinement

Overcoming Creative Blocks

Navigating Creative Blocks

Creativity isn't always a linear process—sometimes, obstacles arise that make it challenging to move forward. Whether it's lack of inspiration, self-doubt, or burnout, finding strategies to push past these barriers is essential for continued growth. One of the biggest challenges I faced was during the Topical Video Project. Initially, I struggled with the concept, unsure of how to balance interactivity, storytelling, and visual design cohesively. This creative block forced me to reflect on my process and apply the strategies I've developed over time to overcome obstacles.

1. Embracing Iteration

Great designs come through experimentation.
